

Inner sanctum

Taller, softer shrubs 1-2 meters in height. Provides a safe haven away from bigger birds. A vine may be grown to provide a protective cover, however may be difficult to manage.

Pomaderris, native *Grevillea*, *Ozothamnus*, *Leptospermum*.

Protective circle

Spiky, protective shrubs 1-2 meters high, planted 20 to 25 cm apart.

Hakea, Acacia ulicifolia, Bursaria, Banksia, Lambertia.

Biodiverse shrub circle

Small, attractive shrubs add interest to a garden for people, birds and animals. This layer provides food and shelter.

Dianella, native Geranium, Indigofera, Prostanthera.

Eating out

Mixed native grasses and ground covers offer a variety of foods from seeds to insects.

Pratia, native Violet, native Geranium, Microlaena.
